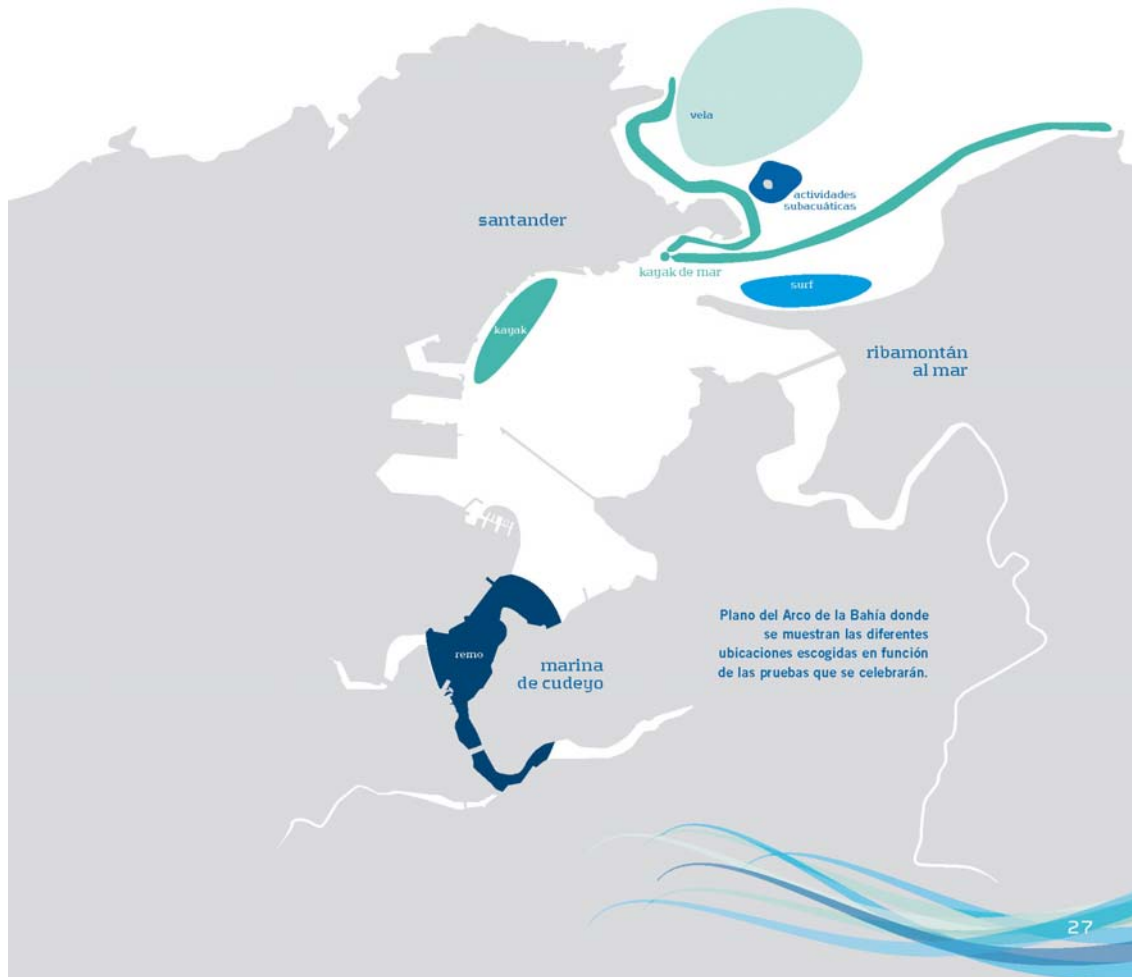

## I. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Atlantic Watersports Games are organized by the **Vice-Presidence of the Cantabrian Government through the General Direction of the European Affairs and Development Cooperation**, with the joint effort of:

Town of Santander  
Town of El Astillero  
Town of Marina de Cudeyo  
Regional Federations, Watersports Clubs and Sports Associations

## II. RULES

### 2.1 The competition will be governed by the Racing Rules of the following International Federations:

International Sailing Federation  
International Canoe Federation  
Federation Internationale des Sociétés d'Aviron  
International Surfing Association  
Confédération Mondiale des Activités Subaquatiques

And by:

The competition rules of the International Committee of the Interceltic and Atlantic Area Watersports Games  
The 2010 Atlantic Watersports Games general Notice of Race  
The rules of the international sailing classes  
The Notice of Race for each sport  
And the Race Instructions for each discipline.

### 2.2 Publicity

Competitors may be required to display sponsor advertising supplied by the organising authority.

### **2.3 Filming, broadcasting**

Competitors may be:

- Photographed
- Filmed for the productions of videos and a DVD
- Interviewed for the press
- Have their names and images published in the press, the web site of the Games.

All documents could be used by the International Committee.

### **III. CLASSES (schedule in annex)**

### **IV. SUPPLIED EQUIPMENT**

A sport (including disqualification of the competitor) or financial penalty may be given and the use of a boat may be withdrawn if, in the opinion of the organising authority, a competitor treats or handles a boat or a board without care or in a manner which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat or the board.

The organising authority will not supply technical devices, or accessories, or any other personal equipment.

No modifications to a boat or a board shall be made without unless authorised by the organising authority.

### **V. ELIGIBILITY**

#### **5.1 Citizenship and licences**

Every competitor must be a member of a club/federation of the country or region which is entering him/her and must own the sport licence corresponding or have Civil Liability insurance. The International Committee will resolve all applications or disputes relating to the determination of the national or the regional authority which a competitor may represent.

#### **5.2 Flags**

Each team is required to bring the venues their national or regional flag, in approximate size 1.5 x 1m, and a CD with the national or regional anthem.



## VI. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### 6.1 Teams

The countries and regions will have to communicate the number of competitors of their teams before April, 29<sup>th</sup> 2010, as a pre-registration.

### 6.2 Entries

The entries must be submitted from **May, 1st to July, 23<sup>rd</sup> 2010 on the International Committee web site <http://www.jniea.eu> ([contact@jniea.eu](mailto:contact@jniea.eu))**, by the national or regional authorities of the competitors taking part in the Atlantic Watersports Games.

The registration made between May, 1<sup>st</sup> to June, 30<sup>th</sup> will have a registration fee of 40€.

Late entries, from July, 1<sup>st</sup> until July, 23<sup>rd</sup> 2010, will have a registration fee of 55€ per competitor.

If a competitor wants to take part in several sports, he or she will have to pay registration fees for each of the sports he or she wants to take part in.

A competitor taking part in several disciplines of a same sport will only pay one registration fee.

### **6.3 Tasks of the national or regional authorities**

The invited regional or national organisers have to:

- Select the teams
- Gather information from competitors
- Submit team details, the entry applications and fees to the International Committee.
- Coordinate and pay for transport of their teams.
- Coordinate and pay for accommodation and catering of their teams.

### **6.4 Late entries**

The Committee reserves the right to accept late entries. (After July, 23<sup>rd</sup> 2010).

### **6.5 Confirmation of the Registration**

The confirmation will be done on July the 31<sup>st</sup> from 10 a.m to 7 p.m, and on August the 1<sup>st</sup> from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m on the Village of the Games by the Team Leaders.

The following documents will have to be presented:

- Sports licence (countries or regions owning it).
- Civil Liability Insurance certificate. (Countries or regions who don't have federative licence)
- Parental approval (when necessary)

### **6.6 Security**

All established security norms must be respected, generally speaking, and for each different sport.

## **VII. ACCOMODATION, CATERING, BOAT RENTAL AND DAMAGE DEPOSITS**

### **7.1 Accommodation and catering**

The Organising Committee will provide accommodation and catering, from lunch time on July the 31<sup>st</sup> to breakfast on August the 6<sup>th</sup>.

By arrangement, accommodation can be made earlier (from July the 30<sup>th</sup> to August the 6<sup>th</sup>), for the same price as during the Games, if communicated in writing when the reservation was made.

### **7.2 Rental of boats**

The J80 are the boats of the RCM Santander members. One boat per region will be drawn. Each crew will be composed of 4 or 5 sailors of the concerned region (338 kg max.). Another person, the owner of the boat, will be on board (90 kg max.).

A 500€ rental instalment will be demanded for the use of cruiser. The rental will be effective when confirmed the inscription on 31<sup>st</sup> of July and 1<sup>st</sup> of August.

### **7.3 Damage deposit**

A 500€ damage retrievable deposit will be demanded for the use of cruiser. The payment of all damages could be demanded if the fixing exceeds the amount of the deposit.

### **7.4 Insurance of the competitors**

**An Insurance fee will be required for registration for the competitors who are not insured through the membership of their Federations: 15 €**

### **IX. SCORING**

The scoring in each class (discipline) will be valid if at least 3 countries or regions are represented in the relevant class (discipline). Each sport committee will establish the scoring system in its race instructions.

### **X. PARTICULAR INSTRUCTIONS**

The particular instructions will be available for all competitors at registration confirmation in the Santander Village of the Games (Carpa, located on the R.C.M.S pier).

### **XI. INTERNATIONAL JURY**

In all the disciplines competing, an international jury will be appointed by the Organisation Committee with the agreement of the International Committee.

### **XII. DRUG TESTING**

Drug testing may take place during the competition.

### **XIII. MEASUREMENT**

Measurement checks may be carried out by the race committees at any time on any boat or board to ensure compliance with the rules.

### **XIV. LIABILITY**

The competitors take part in the Games under their own responsibility.

Neither the organising authority nor any person or entities involved in the organisation of the event accept any liability for injury or loss of life or property caused by or in conjunction with the Games.

The competitor is free to choose to participate or not to a competition.

The organisation Committee could demand the payment of any damage provoked by the wrong use of nautical installations and official accommodation. It could also evict any competitor for bad behaviour, independently from the actions of the Jury.

- Sport country results in sailing, surfing, rowing, canoeing, diving, for the 3 first countries (if a minimum of 3 invited countries or regions take part in each sport).
- Overall country ranking all sports included (if a minimum of 3 invited countries or regions take part in the Games)
