Racing will take place from Traeth Bychan, Anglesey.

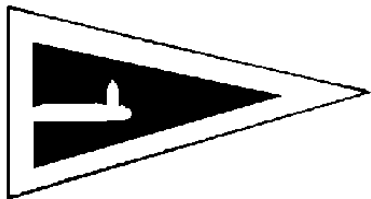
