

Wales Windsurfing National 3 @ CH Pwllheli SC 21st August 2010

Rules

Competition will take place under the Racing Rules of Sailing, except where amended:

1. Here in the Notice of Race
2. In the Sailing Instructions
3. At the briefing

Classes

Racing will take place in the following classes: Up to 5.5m and over 5.5m (max.7.8m) each class refers to the **maximum** sail size which can be used. Smaller sails can be used, especially in windy conditions.

Any board and rig can be used in the 3.5m, 4.5m and 5.5m classes, although sailors are encouraged to use a Techno 293d.

All boards should have a daggerboard or central fin. Board length should measure 320cm or less in the smaller sail size class. Anyone sailing a 3.5msail; small diameter masts & booms should ideally be used with junior sails..

Trophies

Prizes will be awarded to the top three places in each class.

A Techno Award will be presented to the first Techno sailor outside of the top three.

Up to three Merit Awards may be presented at each event.

Age

If a competitor is 21 or under, he/she can enter an event.

Rights to use names and likenesses

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

Terms and Conditions

1. Entry must be made on the day of competition.
2. The first briefing time will be 10.30am on the day.
3. The first race will not start before 11.00am.
4. Buoyancy aids must be worn.
5. All competitors must be an RYA personal member (Junior membership starts at just £5.00). You should ideally join online in advance, but can join on the day if necessary.
6. Competitors must hold valid third party insurance to a sum of £2,000,000 (free with RYA membership, when windsurfing is specified as an interest).
